Information about FILM Juneau Contest:

Concept: To create a video that promotes Juneau.

Who: This contest is open to all interested film and videographers. The contest is sponsored by CBJ, JAHC, and JEDC.

Contest Rules: The video may be no more than 3 minutes long, and must contain elements from each of the following 5 areas:

1. Economy – examples: fishing, tourism, mining, and government.
2. Quality of Life – examples: arts, festivals, education (K-12, UAS), recreational opportunities (skiing, boating, hiking), scenic beauty.
3. Alaska's Capital City – examples: tie in elements of Alaska's Legislature, governor, legislative session.
4. Geography – examples: Juneau's unique topography, mountains, glaciers, waterways.
5. People and History – examples: Juneau's gold mining history, Juneau's rich cultural diversity (Tlingits, Haida, Filipino).

Prize: the winner will receive a cash prize, recognition at an awards ceremony on April 2, 2010, and the video will be prominently featured on the websites of CBJ, JAHC, and JEDC. The CBJ websites receive more than a million hits per month by organizations and individuals worldwide.

Award Ceremony: A film showing and award ceremony will take place on Friday April 2, 2010 at Centennial Hall. Entries will be judged by a panel of judges, and the audience will also have a chance to vote on the winning film. The top ten entries will be shown at the awards ceremony.
