



**RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors**

Resolution 2-10

**WHEREAS**, Google has launched a national search for communities in which to build and test an ultrafast broadband network; and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that Google will cover all costs associated with building and establishing this network; and

**WHEREAS**, Google promises open access to this network; and

**WHEREAS**, Google promises to offer a choice of service providers for access to this network at competitive prices; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and Borough of Juneau (CBJ) recognizes the extraordinary benefits that Google's network would accrue for Juneau's overall economy as well as for municipal and state government, business, education, health and human services, and overall quality of life in the capital city; and

**WHEREAS**, CBJ has asked the Juneau Economic Development Council (JEDC) to coordinate the process of submitting an application to Google on CBJ's behalf;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The JEDC Board of Directors supports and endorses CBJ's application to Google, entitled JuneauBroadband, to build and test a 1-gigabit throughput broadband network in Juneau with open access and a choice of service providers at competitive prices; and
2. The JEDC Board of Directors recommends that the Juneau Assembly adopt a resolution to support and endorse the JuneauBroadband application.

On this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2010, the Juneau Economic Development Council supports submitting a response to **Google to build an Ultrafast Broadband Network in Juneau.**
