General Description: Aiding Women in Abuse & Rape Emergencies (AWARE), Inc.: Providing safe and secure shelter for women and children is AWARE's highest priority. Since 1985, AWARE has provided emergency shelter to clients at Dove Cottage, a forty-eight bed facility located approximately two miles from downtown Juneau. Dove Cottage is staffed 24 hours a day by trained advocates or volunteers. We provide services to women and children to maintain the integrity of our mission. Our goals include educating and engaging youth in changing the climate of tolerance of violence against women and children in order to end domestic and sexual abuse.
