- Deliver health education information by coordinating activities/community events and campaigns in Juneau like Kick Butts Day, Alcohol Awareness Month, etc)
- Provide information and referrals on prevention and treatment at health fairs
- Provide health education information via online tools like Facebook and the NCADD website
- Monitor support for youth by inputting data into electronic health records
- Coordinate community support services for patients and parents and document services in electronic health records
- Gather feedback on NCADD programs by holding focus groups with Juneau youth
- Adhere to the rules, regulations, and code of conduct as specified in the Member Service Agreement
- Will not engage in any AmeriCorps' Prohibited Activities as listed in the member Service Agreement
