



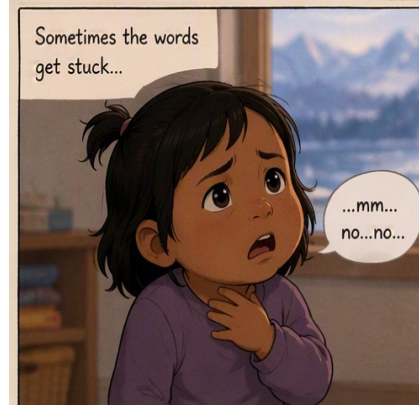

Medicaid Waiver Intellectual and Physical Disabilities Foot Path to Services in SE Alaska



Her parents bring her to see her doctor and talked about the challenges that she is facing. The doctor suggested conducting a neurological evaluation and tests to determine what is happening with her.



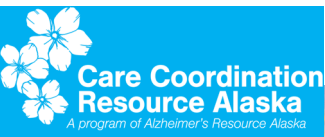


Nova Sparks' parents contact Southeast Alaska Independent Living (SAIL), the local Developmental Disabilities Resource Connection (DDRC) to request a Developmental Disability Determination. Her parents show medical records of a qualifying diagnosis like Intellectual Disability, Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Epilepsy or other related conditions. They completed a Developmental Disabilities Registration and Review form (DDRR). Nova is placed on a waiting list for the State of Alaska known as the DD Registry. Names are drawn from the list based on score and slots available.

Nova has entered school and is working with an aide. Her doctors have been seen her regularly. Her parents think that she needs more support.



Nova was drawn from the waiting list with a "Notice to Proceed" letter. SAIL provides her parents with a list of care coordinators to contact.



The Care Coordinator assists to coordinate with the State of Alaska for a Level of Care Assessment (ICAP). Her parents apply online for Alaska Medicaid. (<https://health.alaska.gov/en/services/division-of-public-assistance-dpa-services/>) The care coordinator helped develop a Plan of Care that outlines the types of supports Nova needs at home, in the community, and at school.
