Medicaid Waiver Foot Path to Services in SE Alaska



1 Walker Wade is getting older. He can't take care of all his daily needs on his own anymore. He needs help at home so he can keep living independently.



2 He went to see his doctor and talked about the challenges that he is facing with cooking, shopping, cleaning, preparing meals, and that he is frightened about falling because he can not stand for long periods of time. The doctor suggested getting in-home care. Following his appointment, he applied online for Alaska Medicaid. 3 Walker Wade called Southeast Alaska Independent Living (SAIL), his local Aging & Disability Resource Center to request a Person Centered Intake also known as a PCI to determine if he will meet the requirements for a Medicaid Waiver to help him pay and coordinate services.

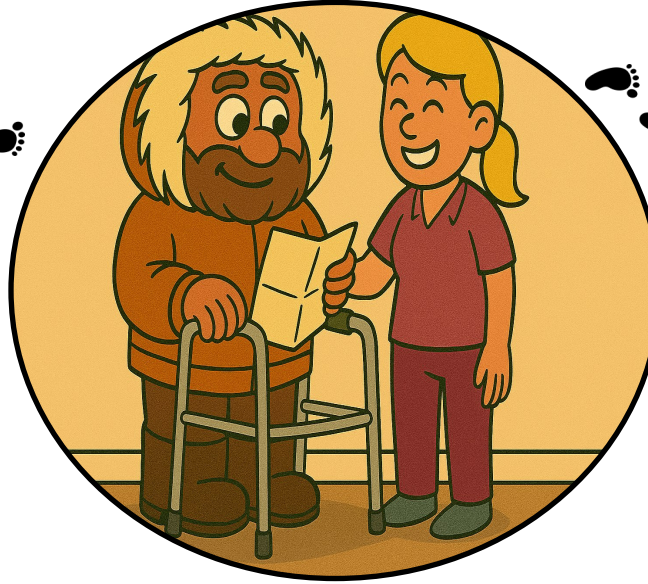

Walker Wade was given a list by SAIL of care coordinators to interview. He spoke to several people before making a decision on who to choose. The Care Coordinator helped him to complete the paperwork for the State of Alaska.

Walker Wade was contacted by his Care Coordinator and told that he was approved for the Medicaid Waiver. They created a Plan of Care for services. He contacted a local Home and Community Service agency to set up caregivers.
